



A Community of Friends is making strides in animal welfare through our Wellness Clinics and specialized Spay/Neuter events, generously supported by grant funding.

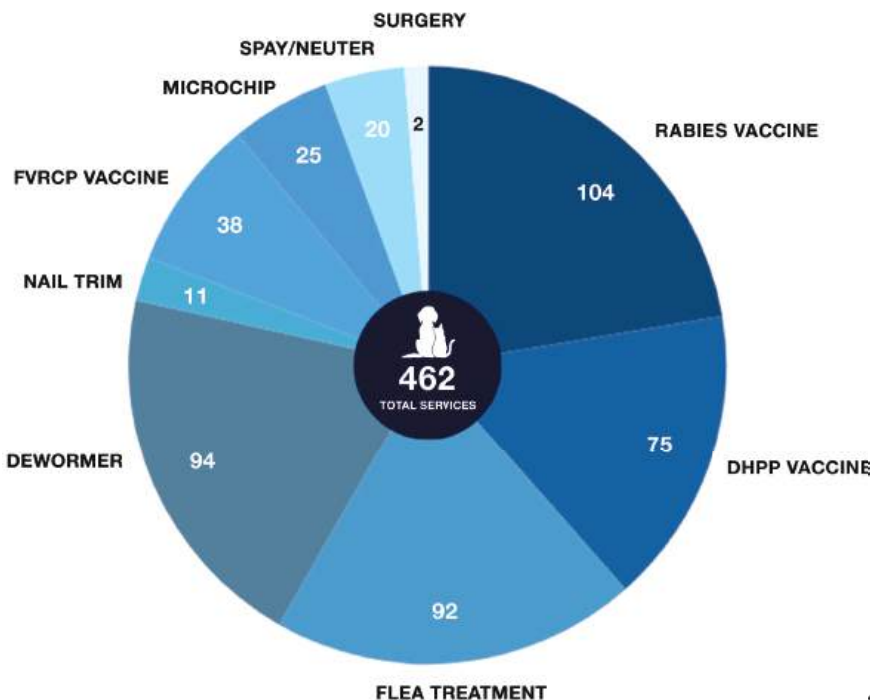
In 2023 and 2024 we hosted five pet wellness clinics and one specialized Spay/Neuter clinic at ACOF buildings in Boyle Heights, Pacoima, North Hills, South Los Angeles, and Lincoln Heights.

These events, conducted in collaboration with betterTogether Forever and the Latino Alliance for Animal Care Coalition, delivered services including vaccinations, flea treatments, nail trimming, deworming, microchipping, medically necessary grooming, and emergency care.

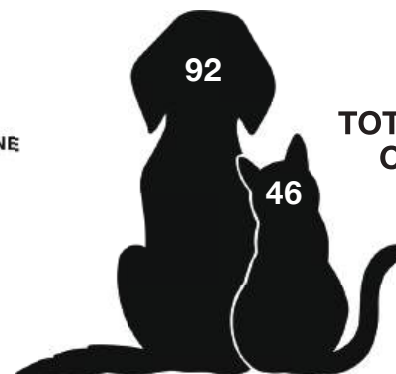
In addition to providing essential animal health services, we also distributed pet food and toys, and provided pet owners with invaluable information and resources about animal care and the importance of microchipping, spaying, and neutering.

Fifty percent of ACOF households include pets or service animals, making the Pet Wellness Program a vital component of our permanent supportive housing model that enriches the lives of tenants and their animal companions.
